Trusting in him, I pray: God, have mercy on me, a sinner.

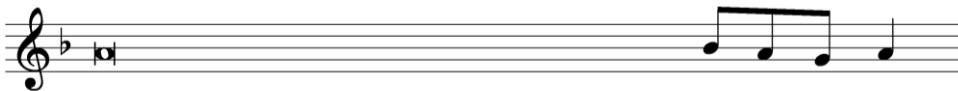
